| Largest Operational Scale Ever <i>Enhanced support for young musicians</i> Rohm Music Foundation : 2007 Operations |

Since it was established in 1991, the Rohm Music Foundation has implemented a range of activities with the objective of contributing to musical culture as follows.

In fiscal 2007, the Foundation will work to further enhance its activities, centered on support and assistance.

1. The Foundation's operating expenses will be up substantially, to ¥658.5 million, an increase from the previous fiscal year of ¥254 million, or 73%. This is the largest operational scale in the Foundation's history.
2. Especially, Scholarship support will be ¥169.1 million, an increase of ¥41 million, or 32% from the previous fiscal year. To promote ongoing advancement in music, the Foundation will further increase its support so that young musicians can continue to enhance their abilities. In addition, by continuing to implement a broad range of activities, such as assistance for concerts and other musical activities, sponsorship of the Kyoto International Music Students Festival, production of "Rohm Music Foundation CD Reproduction Series from a 78rpm(SP) Record Collection <A Selection of Japanese 78rpm Recordings> ", and new project, financial support for orchestra concerts and CD releases the foundation will work to make an even more active contribution to the development of musical culture.
